ENTER TO WIN

Winner = \$500

A winner will be chosen by the SA based on the criteria: use of theme, creativity, originality, design quality, design format (adaptable for use), representation of the Student Association, and overall eligibility.

Participation Prizes = \$100

Participants whose design work is shortlisted can win \$100 in gift cards.

The SA believes that student artists should be compensated and offers this participation prize in recognition of the hard work that goes into each piece of submitted work. Odds dependent on number and quality of entries; approx. 10 available.

ELIGIBILITY: All can enter. Must be current student/recent graduate (within last year) of GB to win.

► **Students United**

Students have an extraordinary amount of power when they work together. What do you envision it looks like when students come together to demand change?

► **Toronto, your home away from home**

You've spent a lot of time in the city during your studies. What have you seen, how has being in the city changed you, what are the things you've done? Showcase Toronto through your eyes, in your art.

► **George Brown Polytechnic**

George Brown has gone through a lot of changes over the last year. Showcase in your artwork what the changes mean to you, or how they've impacted you, your classmates and the city.

► **Your Student Association**

What does the Student Association mean to you? How has your time been impacted at George Brown in a positive way because of the SA? Share your experiences through artwork

***Chosen artwork will be reworked with you or printer as needed.**

- **CMYK**
- **300+ dpi images and vectors for line art**
- **text/design to include: "The Source" or "THE SOURCE", and "2026-2027"**
- **Avoid use of additional text or logos. Required content will be incorporated or edited upon selection.**
- **Do not use copyrighted artwork, or photos without consent.**

Entries created with Artificial Intelligence will not be accepted. Those submitting designs made with AI will also not be eligible for participation prizes.

- Program of Study
- 100 word description of your entry.

Winner(s) will be required to submit the original adobe illustrator - or similar program - file.

Failure to include any of the above may result in disqualification or forfeiture of prize.
